

## **Call for Papers: Special Issue of Earth, Planets and Space (EPS) “Tsunami: Science, Technology, and Disaster Mitigation”**

This issue of EPS will be devoted to the 3rd International Tsunami Field Symposium held in Sendai, Japan in April, 2010. It will contain the papers presented at this particular symposium following the regular EPS submission procedures. Contributions should discuss any aspect of tsunami. Papers must be of international interest and should follow the scope of EPS. All kinds of tsunami research such as geology, geomorphology, coastal engineering, remote sensing, numerical modeling, and disaster mitigation are the subject of discussion.

All submitted papers go through a peer review process, wherein experts review, recommend, or reject the papers for publishing. Submitted papers should not have been previously published nor be currently under consideration for publication elsewhere. Nonnative authors are strongly recommended to be checked the manuscript by native English speakers. Papers must be submitted to the EPS editorial office. Electronic submissions by e-mail to [eps@terrapub.co.jp](mailto:eps@terrapub.co.jp) are encouraged, but authors who meet any difficulties with electronic submissions could submit a hard copy by post. The cover letter should mention “Submitted to the Special Issue: Tsunami”. After papers are accepted, the authors will receive instructions for the final manuscript from the editorial office. The deadline for manuscript submissions is 31 October 2010. This special issue will hopefully be published in September 2011.
